- 3 Normally the details on this document are machine printed. If they are hand written you may arrange to exchange it for a free printed version at the Vehicle Test Station that issued this document.
- 4 To view the vehicle's available MOT History (including mileage recorded at the time of the test) visit our website www.motinfo.gov.uk. Alternatively you can have a written history posted to you by calling the MOT History Check Service on 0906 1209941** calls cost £1.50 per minute from a BT landline; calls from mobiles and other networks may vary. To check the MOT history you will need the registration mark of the vehicle and either the test number from the MOT test certificate or the document reference number from the V5C Registration Certificate. Lines are open from 6am to 10pm 7 days a week.
